## Classification

Competitors will be classified based upon their declared average based upon the best 4 scores from the last 5 officially scored targets in a league competition at either 50M (PL7 ex200) or 20yrd (PL14 ex100) range which must be verified. If no average is declared then you will be placed in Class A. The Committee reserves the right to re-classify any competitor at any time.

Class boundaries (TBC)

A = 180.0+    B = 172.5 > 179.9    C = 165.0 > 172.4    D = < 164.9

The Meeting is self squadding and will commence at 09.30 and finish at 15.30. Please enter your squadding preferences on the entry form. All competitors will be squadded according to their preference on a first come first served basis.

## Rifles

Only .22LR cartridge rifle complying with NSRA LSR specification (Rule 8.3.3) may be used, this is an 'any sights' competition i.e. telescope sight may be used, but not any lasers or any sighting system that projects an image onto the target. Slings are prohibited.

## Prizes

Prizes will be awarded down to 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each class (2<sup>nd</sup> place if less than 6 in a class) with further awards for Juniors (aged under 18 on the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2019), Ladies, Veterans (aged over 60 on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2019), Open Pairs, C&D Pairs and Teams of Three. Separate 'Open' and 'C&D' pair prizes are dependent upon sufficient numbers entering in classes.

## Procedure

All Targets are to be collected from the Stats office on arrival. The meeting is self-squadding and competitors shall ensure that each target card is marked with their competitor's number, firing point and the detail number.

Competitors are to be ready to take up their position at the firing point 10 minutes before the start of their allotted detail. Each squad will receive a briefing prior to taking their positions.

The Competition will use PL7 targets on provided frames.

**Each squad will comprise of an initial 5 minute (unlimited shot) sighting detail followed by 3 further details of 15 minutes each per target, twenty shots to count, with ten minutes to change targets.** 4 to 6 large bulldog clips will be required to secure the target board.

## Range Safety

All shooting will be strictly in accordance with the displayed Range Orders and will be controlled by a Range Conducting Officer who must be obeyed at all times.

Breech flags are to be inserted into all rifles when on the firing point and not in use (and all magazines are to be removed).

## Scores

Competitors must ensure that their scores are correctly recorded before leaving the Meeting. A score may be challenged on a deposit of £2.00 which will be refunded if the challenge is upheld. Chippenham R & PC will not enter into any correspondence regarding missing or disputed scores after the Meeting has closed.

## Data Protection

It is planned that results for this competition will be posted on the Chippenham Rifle & Pistol Club website. The information will contain your initials, surname and score as well as club and class.

## Directions

### Sat. Nav. SN15 2NP

**From the motorway:** Leave the M4 at junction 17 and follow the A350 dual carriageway south towards Chippenham. At the end of the dual carriageway take a right turn at the roundabout following the A350 towards Warminster. Follow this road for approx. 3 miles negotiating 5 roundabouts. At the 5<sup>th</sup> roundabout (adjacent to McDonalds) take the second exit onto the A4 towards Chippenham. Follow this road for approx. 0.5m (passing Sainsburys on left) (negotiating two roundabouts and a set of traffic lights, B&Q on right). As you pass under the railway bridge turn right at a mini roundabout towards Melksham. Proceed along B4528 for 300yds past houses on the left until the road bends right, where there is a lay-by on left hand side. Pull into the lay-by and follow a track for 50yds turning right through a gate, through some allotments and the range is found at the end of the track. Please observe the 10mph speed limit along the track.

**From Melksham:** Follow the A350 from Melksham passing through Beanacre and Notton for approx. 4 miles until you come to a roundabout. Take the second exit onto the B4528 and follow for 0.5m until you reach a set of traffic lights. Turn right and follow the B4528 for a few hundred yards where the road bends to the left and a lay-by is situated on the right in front of some houses. Pull into the lay-by and follow a track for 50yds turning right through a gate, through some allotments and the range is found at the end of the track. Please observe the 10mph speed limit along the track.

**From Chippenham Town Centre:** Follow the A4 out of Chippenham past the hospital (on the left) and down the hill until you come to a mini roundabout adjacent to a brick railway viaduct. Take the first exit and follow the B4528 towards Melksham. Proceed along B4528 for 300yds past houses on the left until the road bends right, where there is a lay-by on left hand side. Pull into the lay-by and follow a track for 50yds turning right through a gate, through some allotments and the range is found at the end of the track. Please observe the 10mph speed limit along the track.
